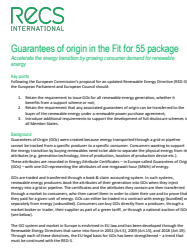
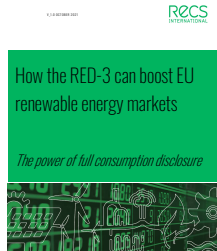

RECS' principal policy demand is FCD to secure Transparency

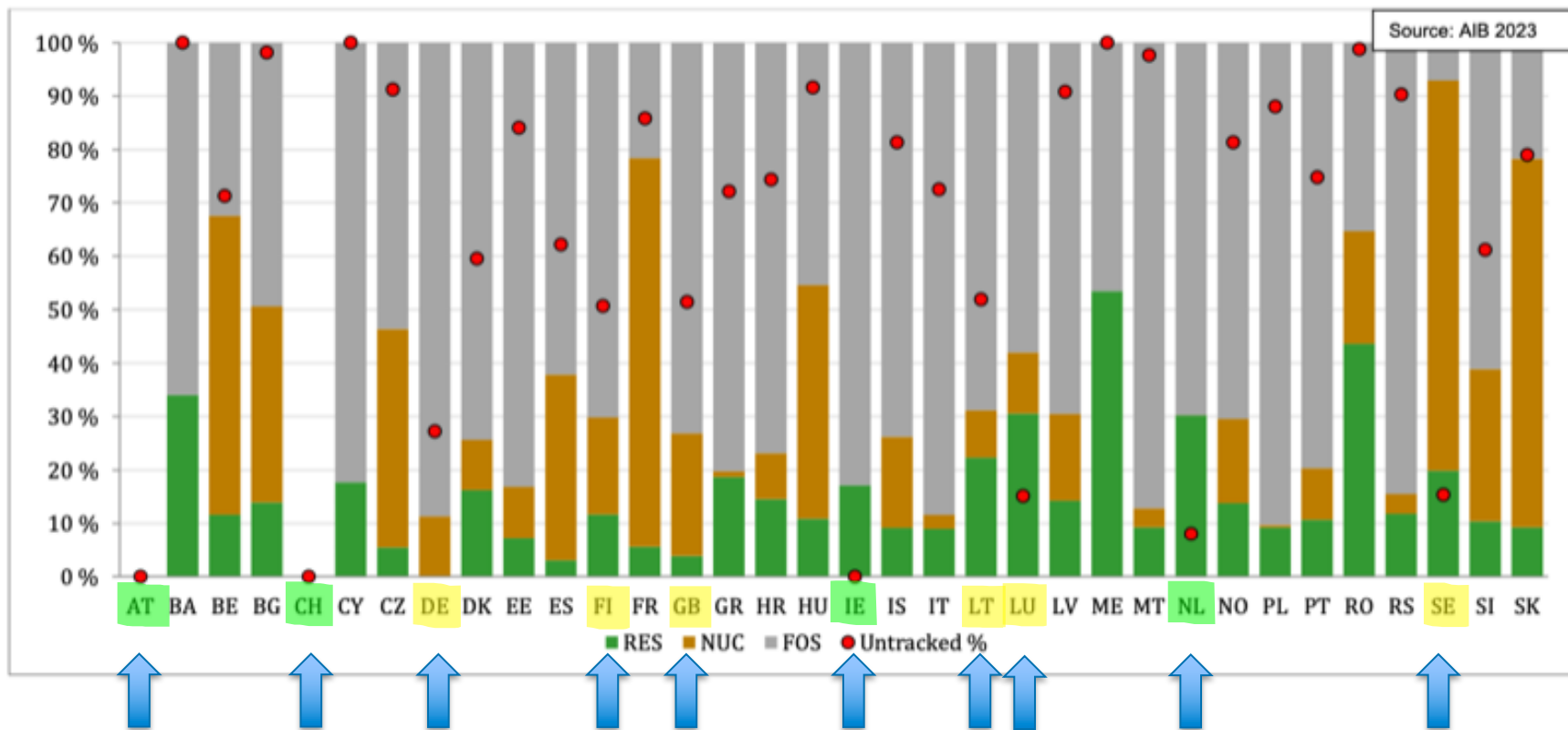
